Dr Andy Hayes

Dr Andy Hayes received his D.D.S., M.S.D. and certificate in orthodontics from Indiana University.

He is listed as “inventor” on multiple active orthodontic patents pertaining to Class II correction devices and has worked in conjunction with American Orthodontics to develop a simplified orthodontic bite correcting appliance named PowerScope.

Dr Hayes currently operates a single doctor private practice limited to orthodontics, is a Clinical Instructor in the St. Louis University Department of Orthodontics and has presented lectures pertaining to Class II correction on 3 continents. He has authored multiple articles pertaining to this subject and serves on the Editorial Advisory Board of Orthotown Magazine.

Simplified and Evidence-Based Class II Correction in the 21st century. **8:00AM– 11:30AM**

Class II correction appliances have been utilized in orthodontics for well over 100 years. Class II fads, theories, and protocols seem to come and go and then come back again.

This lecture will take a brief historical look at Class II correction appliances through the years up to the current day. It seems that the only thing that is certain when it comes to Class II correction with fixed or removable appliances is that it is and has always been highly controversial.

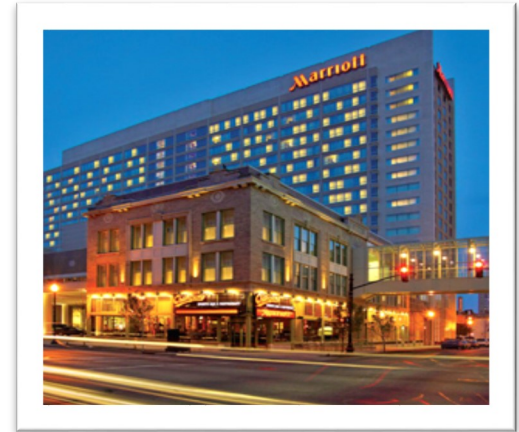
This lecture will provide an evidence-based look at class II correction focusing on the biomechanics of Class II treatment with the PowerScope Class II Corrector.

Dr Hayes will demonstrate a wide variety of class II correction cases from straightforward Class II and asymmetry cases as well as unconventional uses such as Class Correctors as mini screw alternatives, space closure for dental substitution and space opening aids prior to dental implants. Most importantly, the mechanics of Class II correction will be explained.

Unfortunately, open eruption for the treatment of palatally displaced canines is the best kept secret in all of orthodontics. In this lecture, Dr Hayes will provide insight into this commonly misunderstood method for quickly, easily, and almost painlessly bringing in those tough palatal canines. If you have ever had a bad experience with open eruption, have been hesitant to try it, or just don't understand what the excitement is about- this lecture is for you! This will address the conventional open eruption procedure and treatment mechanics and also introduce a new flapless surgical treatment protocol that patients (and surgeons) are loving!
