ANNUAL REPORT 2011

Highlights of a number of activities in the Division of Orthodontics at the University of Louisville during the 2010-2011 academic year:

Clinic Update

The University of Louisville School of Dentistry is in the final stages of a major renovation scheduled to be completed at the end of July 2011. The orthodontic clinic has received a makeover during this process and the changes have been dramatic. Along with our clinic, the entire third floor has been renovated to add an expanded centralized reception area for all specialties to encourage a more interdisciplinary approach to care. Additional space has been designated for the residents of all department specialties. Also, two (2) new consultation offices, two (2) additional offices for patient coordinators and an enlargement of the orthodontic laboratory were incorporated into the department's new floor plan. In addition, the specialties of Endodontics and Periodontics were relocated to the third floor and are now consolidated along with most of the other postgraduate specialty programs to better serve our patients. Four (4) newly updated interdisciplinary lecture rooms and a distance learning room have also been added. These renovations allow us to offer our patients the best possible care and facilitate an outstanding learning environment for our residents.

Retirement Celebration for Dr. Moshiri

Dr. Farhad Moshiri retired from his teaching and clinical duties at the University of Louisville on June 30, 2011. Dr. Moshiri has served this program faithfully for 28 years and he will be greatly missed. To celebrate his retirement, the UofL Orthodontic Alumni Association is planning a social dinner on the night of October 27. The next day, October 28, Drs. Farhad and Maz Moshiri will present a joint lecture. Dr. Farhad Moshiri will be discussing the importance of early interceptive treatment, current treatment modalities of orthognathic surgery patients, as well as his experiences gained with TMD patients over the past 30 years. Dr. Maz Moshiri will present a lecture on the benefits of Invisalign and will discuss how to properly evaluate clinchecks, the importance of excellent communication with the lab technician, along with trouble-shooting these cases. This lecture will continue this university's commitment to provide exceptional continuing education to its alumni, residents and local orthodontists.

Faculty Spotlight

Dr. Baxter "Ed" Johnson began his dental career in 1962 in the US Army Dental Corps as a general dentist after receiving his DDS from the University of Pittsburgh. Following a yearlong tour in Vietnam where he was awarded a Bronze Star for service under hostile fire, Dr. Johnson attended the University of Missouri at Kansas City (UMKC) for his Orthodontic Certificate. He then served as an orthodontist in the Army until retiring from active duty with the rank of Colonel.

Following his career in the Army Dental Corps, Dr. Johnson came to the University of Louisville in 1989. He served as an Associate Professor of the Orthodontic Department and Acting Chair until 1992, then Chairman of the Department until 2008. Presently, he serves as Professor Emeritus and continues to teach one day a week as a Clinical Professor, along with teaching a course on treatment planning.

Dr. Johnson most recently was recognized as the 2011 Distinguished Orthodontist of the Year at the Orthodontic UMKC Alumni Luncheon held on April 8, in conjunction with the Midwest Dental Conference in Kansas City, Missouri. The past president of the American Board of Orthodontics, Dr. Vance Dykehouse, presented him with the award.
