Once again, it is time to give a summary of some important activities and achievements associated with the University of Louisville's Orthodontic Program during the academic year of 2015/2016.

1. Successful Completion of CODA Inspection

After nearly two years of preparation for the Commission of Dental Accreditation (CODA) visit during September of 2015, I am delighted to report a very positive outcome for ULSD and all of the specialty programs that make up our Department during these very rigorous inspections. I would like to take this opportunity to express my sincere appreciation to all our faculty, residents, students and staff for their dedication, professionalism and hard work during the visit. Their valuable contributions were certainly essential for the highly successful outcome of this intense and important process. We are very proud of this major accomplishment, but more importantly, how it bodes a bright future for the divisions of Orthodontics and Pediatric Dentistry, the Department and ULSD.

2. <u>Welcoming a New Dean.</u>

After a nationwide search for a new Dean, Dr. T. Gerard Bradley has been appointed as Dean of ULSD effective August 1, 2016. Dr. Bradley has an impressive record of academic leadership, teaching and research. He comes to UofL from Marquette University where he had been most recently the Associate Dean of Research and Graduate Studies for the School of Dentistry. While there he had also previously served as the Chair of Developmental Sciences/Orthodontics and the Program Director of Advanced Education in Orthodontics. Originally from Ireland, he obtained his dental degree from Cork University and later went on to advance his training by earning a Master of Science and Orthodontic Advanced Training at The Ohio State University. We also want to express our gratitude to Dr. John Sauk who is stepping down as Dean. Dr. Sauk served as Dean for nine years. Under his leadership, the Dental School made great strides, including: unprecedented growth in the number of oral health care providers trained, establishment of a combined D.M.D.-Ph.D. program and a D.M.D.-M.B.A. joint program with the College of Business, as well as establishing several new clinics/offices throughout the area to help meet the community's needs for good oral health care.

3. New Full-Time Orthodontic Faculty Member.

Dr. Nandakumar Janakiraman has been appointed as an Assistant Professor in the Department of Orthodontics, Pediatric Dentistry and Special Care effective June 1, 2016. As an Assistant Professor for the Division of Orthodontics, Dr. Janakiramna's primary responsibilities will include all areas of Orthodontic teaching, research mentoring and clinical supervision.

Dr. Janakiraman comes to U of L from the University of Connecticut, Department of Orthodontics where he has been teaching for the past two years. His research interest has been concentrated in the area of three-dimensional imaging application in the field of Orthodontics and evidence-based orthodontic techniques and outcomes.

Dr. Janakiraman received a Doctor of Dental Surgery from the Government Dental College, Bangalore University, India in 1998; a Master's in Orthodontics from Government Dental College, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh, India in 2002; a Fellowship in Orthodontics at the School of Dental Medicine, University of Connecticut Health Center, Farmington, Connecticut in 2011; a Certificate of Specialty with a MDentSc in Orthodontics from the School of Dental Medicine, University of Connecticut Health Center, Farmington, Connecticut, in 2014.
